The Stl'atl'imx Tribal Police Service will be escorting Sergeant Michael LEO (Tayus) from the Squamish Funeral Chapel at, 40440 Tantalus Road, Garabaldi Highlands, Squamish British Columbia at 14:00 hours, on October 18, 2023, to the Ullush Community Complex, at 82 IR 10, Lil'wat (Mount Currie, BC).

A traditional wake will be held on October 18, 2023, where friends and family are welcome to share stories, listen to speakers & hand drummers and be present with the family & community.

Sergeant LEO's Funeral service will be on **October 19, 2023 at 09:00 –1500** hours.

STPS Tunic – Uniform with forge cap
Municipal Police: Dress Uniform/Tunic with Medals /Uniform & forge hat.
RCMP – Red Surge with Medals/Uniform with Stetson/forge hat
All other Peace officers /Departments – Tunic/Uniform & forge hat.

The funeral service will be a traditional Lil'wat service with a pipe ceremony,
(Phones on silent & No photos or video recording of the ceremony)

A Very Specific List of Speakers will be chosen to speak during the day of the Ceremony.
(Traditional Státimc style, Chiefs, Family and specific Delegates)

At approximately 13:00 the family has requested that All Police Officers stand together with the community and pall bearers to assist with handing Sgt. LEO to the STPS officers who will place him in a STPS Truck then transport him to the Lil'wat graveyard for his internment which will be complete by 15:00 hours as per Lil'wat traditional protocol.

The Family invites everyone to stay and share a meal with them & the community at Ullush Community Complex at 82 IR 10, Lil'wat (Mt. Currie BC)
