Lillooet STPS & Mt. Currie STPS Offices CLOSED

In light of the COVID-19 virus impacting the Province of BC, the STPS Offices located at 879 Main Street Lillooet and at 357 IR 10 Mt. Currie will be closed to the public effective immediately. Until further notice all non-essential service requests such as fingerprinting and requests to speak with a police officer at the front counter cannot be accommodated. The decision to do so is based on recommendations from the Federal & Provincial Governments.
